They will look at place value of numbers to 50, ordering and comparing amounts as well as building the numbers as tens and ones.  Yr2: Will consolidate their understanding of adding and subtracting 2 digit numbers including money. They will describe the properties of 2D and 3D shapes and compare and measure the mass of objects.</p>
<p><b>Science</b>  Experiments with plants to record what plants need and what happens if they don't have the things they need, planting seeds and monitoring growth, naming plants in our local area.</p>	<p><b>Why?</b>  To explore how things and inventions in the history affect our lives today.</p>	<p><b>History</b>  The children will create a timeline of vehicles. They will be learning about George Stephenson and Henry Ford and their impact on Transport. The children will be making comparisons between old and new.</p>
