<p><b>English</b>  <b>Phonics:</b>  Letters &amp; Sounds (Year 1 Phase 5/Year 2 Phase 6)  <b>Texts:</b> The Snail and the Whale and The Animal book, Poems about  <b>Focus:</b> Non-fiction writing, lists of facts, rhyming phrases, poetry, Sentences with accurate punctuation, Paragraphs (Y2), Spelling reflecting common exception words, Editing and revising, Poetry writing, Rhyming patterns and Author comparisons.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>TRANSPORT      PLANTS</b></p> <div style="display: flex; justify-content: space-around; align-items: center;">   </div>	<p><b>Maths</b>  Yr1: Children will continue to look at the place value of numbers to 50. They will develop their skills by measuring lengths and heights as well as reading and following basic directions.  Yr2: Children will look at how objects can be measured through length mass, capacity and temperatures, including counting scales in 2s, 5s and 10s. They will learn about position and direction by reading and writing their own instructions using positional vocabulary.</p>
<p><b>Science</b>  Continue to work on Plants: Experiments with plants to record what plants need and what happens if they don't have the things they need, planting seeds and monitoring growth, naming plants in our local area. Looking at how our local environment changes in the Summer.</p>	<p><b>Why?</b>  To explore how things change over time: to investigate how plants grow and develop over time, how transport has developed over time and how we change over time.</p>	<p><b>Geography</b>  We will continue to revise our map skills learning the continents and oceans of the world.</p>
<p><b>DT &amp; Art</b>  As part of their History topic the children will make some 3D vehicles.</p>	<p><b>R.E.</b>  Our topic is 'Caring for others in the world'. The children will learn how different religions encourage us to care for people, animals and the world, such as through The Good Samaritan story, a Langer meal and the festival of Raksha Bandhan.</p>	<p><b>PSCHE</b>  Our topic is 'Growing and Changing' and will consist of some lessons discussing how male and female bodies are different with children using the correct vocabulary for body parts.</p>
<p><b>ICT</b>  Purple Mash will be used in conjunction with our maths lessons to learn about programming directions for objects to follow.</p>	<p><b>P.E.</b>  Yr1 children will be taught by Pro Stars on a Monday and the Yr2s will have swimming each week.</p>	<p><b>History</b>  The children will create a timeline of vehicles. They will be learning about George Stephenson and Henry Ford and their impact on Transport. The children will be making comparisons between old and new.</p>
