 - Letters to and from school

Please remember, it will be your child who will have to put it on and off and carry everything inside as we want to focus on increasing their independence so be aware of this when choosing the right size bag for your child.

3. Please practice:
 - putting coats on,
 - taking jumpers or cardigans on and off
 - putting shoes on – if your child is in shoes with laces, they need to be practicing at home please.
4. Drop off is between 08:50 and 09:00 and the inner gate will be monitored between these times. If the gate is not monitored, please take them to the office door.
