

Celebrating Woodside Primary School : For the Week Beginning 22nd November 2021

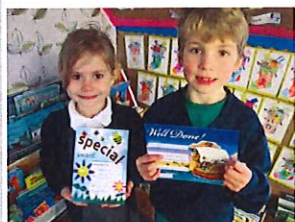
Dear Parents,
