Maths:

We will improve our mental maths skills in our daily Rainbow Maths challenge. In lessons, we will be measuring capacity and time as well as revisiting the position and direction of objects. Our calculation skills will be extended in adding and subtracting larger numbers and embedding our 2, 5 and 10 times tables and corresponding division facts. Each Friday the children's problem solving will be based around algebra.



Literacy:

In Literacy lessons will be consolidating all the areas we have learned throughout the year in reading, comprehension, spelling, grammar and writing. We will look at texts around our topic and write stories using inspiring pictures. We will continue to work on our handwriting and develop our editing skills.




Science:

We will be looking at the different groups of animals (insects, mammals, reptiles, amphibians, birds, fish and arthropods) We will be looking at their habitats and making comparisons. We will be learning about the different foods animals eat and the food chain. We will also look at particular places in our school environment where we may find animals.

ICT:

We will type up our recounts to become more familiar with Word. We will search the internet for information about the creatures we are looking at.



Art/DT:

Our art and design skills will be linked to our R.E. work as we represent the natural world in different creative ways using clay, collage and objects from the natural world.

PE:

We will practise for Sports Day by developing athletics skills and will consolidate our hitting, throwing and catching through rounders.



The children will learn what Christian and Jewish teachings say about looking after our natural world and the people in it.
