

Assessments Term 5 and 6 include the statutory national tests and teacher assessments, which are reported to parents formally at the end of the summer term. These include EYFS profile, Y1 phonics test, Y2 tests and teacher assessment, Y6 tests (reading, grammar, punctuation and spelling, maths) and teacher assessments (writing and science). This year, Y4 children will trial an online times table test which will become statutory in Y4 from next year. Our approach is incorporate tests into normal daily routines so the younger children should not be overly aware or perturbed! The Y6 timetable is as follows.
