### <u>English</u>

Spelling: Continue to work on the common exception words for Year 1 & 2.

As your child grasps the common exception words encourage to use them in a sentence and in their writing. Year 2 children don't forget the other punctuation you have learned (comma's, exclamation marks, question marks and speech
