Covid

GCC update:

Following the government announcement on Monday, there is no change to operational guidance for schools. All control measures should remain in place until the end of term and regular LFD testing should continue.

In the event of a Covid case in school, government advice is now that **any close contact of a PCR positive case is asked to take a PCR test** to assist in containing the spread of Covid beyond the original setting.

Trim Trail and field-safety after school

Our Trim Trail area and field can be used by families after school and we have signage up saying that children should be accompanied, please. This is for the children's safety as the area is quite secluded and we wouldn't want them to have an accident or be at risk in any way.

Some KS2 children have mentioned that they have come back after school unaccompanied and used the Trim trail inappropriately (including standing on top of the Trim Trail tunnel), hence this reminder. Families are more than welcome to use the equipment and we encourage its use.
