### Royal Science Society's Young People's book prize


Children in Woodpecker class have finished reading, judging and voting for their favourite science book for the Royal Science Society. They decided on 'Fourteen Wolves' by Catherine Barr. It is described as:

'In fairy tales, the wolf's cry makes people shudder. They've been hunted, captured. When wolves disappeared from Yellowstone Park in the 1930s, the ecosystem started to collapse. Enormous herds of elk swarmed the plains, bears starved, rabbit families shrunk and birds flew away to new homes. Plants vanished, trees withered and rivers meandered. Until in 1995, wolves returned to

the park and everything began to change for the better.'

The children all felt that they had learnt more about wolves from the story, but also geography as we've had to find out where Yellowstone Park is. They liked the honest approach of the author.

The final result will be announced in March. All of the shortlisted books can be borrowed from Mrs Cotterell, please ask Woodpecker children for their recommendations.
