Why should I apply?

For every child that is entitled to free school meals the school receives extra funding to enhance provision and improve progress and outcomes for children. So please apply even if you do not wish to take up your free school meal.

What do I need to qualify?

Your child might be able to get free school meals if you get any of the following: Income support, Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance, Child Tax Credit, Universal Credit. You will receive an instant response as to whether or not you are entitled to claim. All you need is your National Insurance Number and a current email address. You are very welcome to come and speak to our family worker, Mrs Matthews, or email: gmatthews@woodside.gloucs.sch.uk and we will do our best to support your application.




