Covid udpdate

Please continue to be vigilant for symptoms and book a PCR test for your child if they are symptomatic; isolate until the PCR result is returned; if positive, isolate for at least 5 days and up to 10 days until LFTs show negative.

Now that we are moving to 'living with Covid', the guidance is to cease sending the 'warn and inform' letters for individual cases. We will contact parents of medically vulnerable children though. Warn and inform letters will be sent if outbreak thresholds are met. If this change causes you any worry, please contact us with any queries and we will respond to your feedback.

We currently have very few cases and look forward to re-introducing more mixing such as key stage assemblies. There are new dates and events to look forward to on this newsletter!


