On Wednesday 14th October we will be going to visit Skillzone in Gloucester. It is a centre where children take part in a range of activities to learn and practise how to keep themselves safe. We will be taking part in scenarios in the home and outside to help the children learn what to do in those situations.

There will be no charge for this trip. Children are expected to **wear school uniform**, including a waterproof coat. They will need a small snack and a drink. A packed lunch is advisable as we will be eating it on our return to school. We will be returning at approximately 12.45pm so will have our lunch break then.

Any child who uses a reliever inhaler – Ventolin or similar – must bring their inhaler on the day please as it is a requirement of the centre.

We will be **leaving at 9am prompt**, so please arrive as near to 8.50am as possible. Children coming in later with siblings will need to be earlier on this day.

Covid-19 safety procedures will apply so we will be taking hand sanitizers and tissues. Once we arrive at the centre we will be washing hands and it will only be us in the centre at that time to avoid mixing with other schools. We will be following a specific route around the centre to allow for 2m spacing
