Week 1 (22nd February) a small plant pot and some soil (you will have received some seeds in the post over half term)

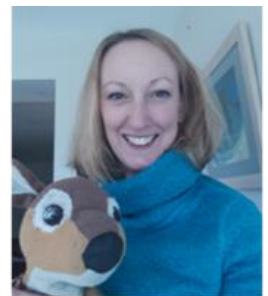
Week 4 (8th March) a jar, kitchen paper and a bean to grow.
