<p><u>English</u> Phonics: Letters & Sounds (Year 1 Phase 5/Year 2 Phase 6) Texts: Meerkat Mail & The day the crayons quit Focus: story mapping, writing stories, writing for different purposes (e.g. postcards and letters, researching authors, exclamation marks, revising and editing.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Toys</u></p> 	<p><u>Maths</u> Yr1: Will be counting in 2s, 5s and 10s. We will double numbers and share amounts into equal groups and arrays. In fractions we will find $\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{1}{4}$ of shapes and amounts. Yr2: Will consolidate addition and subtraction of 2 digit numbers using partitioning and the column method. We will multiply and divide by 2, 5 and 10 and make links to finding fractions: $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{2}{4}$, $\frac{3}{4}$ and $\frac{1}{3}$ of shapes and amounts.</p>
<p><u>Science</u> Habitats: the children will look at the different types of habitats and what animals/plants we would find in each. Gardening: the children will enjoy planting bulbs and seeds early Spring and predicting what will happen and keeping a diary.</p>	<p><u>Why?</u> To explore how toys have changed throughout history and compare the activities we play with today with those of our parents and grandparents. To compare how our toys compare to those around the world whilst learning about different continents and oceans.</p>	<p><u>History</u> The children will create a timeline of toys from the Victorian time until 2022. They will learn about the materials used and the changes over the way toys are made and what type of toys over time.</p>
<p><u>Art/ D&T</u> We will be drawing and painting pictures of our favourite toys, creating collages and mosaics of cuddly toys and using our DT skills to create a wiggly legged spider.</p>	<p><u>R.E.</u> We will finish the story of Moses and make links to current Jewish festivals. The children will learn the importance of the Shema and Mezuzah to Jewish families and explore how Shabbat is celebrated.</p>	<p><u>PSCHE</u> Through the topic of 'Rights and Responsibilities' we will explore how to look after our immediate environment, the need to take care of money and basic first aid that we can give.</p>
<p><u>ICT</u> Purple Mash will be used to teach animated stories which will be linked to our literacy work.</p>	<p><u>P.E.</u> Children will build upon their gymnastics skills by travelling along apparatus and landing safely. They will explore how to improve their work.</p>	<p><u>Geography</u> Children to learn about toys and games in Guatemala, Ghana, Poland, India, Russia and the Philippines. Talk about the toys and games and decide which they'd like to have a go at.</p>
