I'd like you to compare the 2 forests for their location, age, size, rivers, plants, animals. You can use the comparison chart to do this if you want. You are seeing how they are the same, how they are different. | <u>RE</u> Tuesday 16 th February, during half term, is Shrove Tuesday. So for this lesson I'd like to look at the start of the Christian festival of Lent. This is usually where something is given up for Lent, for 40 days. I'd like you to create a factfile/poster with lots of information about Lent. What is it, why is it celebrated, when, by whom? What is the history behind it?
