English



Reading: Aim to read every day! Read books you have at home, even the tricky ones can be shared with someone at home. The BBC have lots of online audio stories which are added to each week and a lovely variety for your children to choose from www.bbc.co.uk

Spelling: Continue to work on the common exception words for Year 1 & 2.

Writing: We have started a new topic this week on 'Wildlife'. Each day we are choosing a different animal we see in our garden to write about. Today it was our cheeky squirrel! Remember....Aiming to write a sentence a day would be great. Remind your child to include a finger spaces, capital letters and full stops. Year 2 children don't forget the other punctuation you have learned (comma's, exclamation marks, question marks and speech marks) and also those connecting words (because, but, then, also, so, and) You could keep a diary, write a recount of something you've done, write stories or make an information booklet. www.robinhoodmat.co.uk has lots of writing ideas to help you at home.
