<p><b><u>English</u></b>  Yr1: Will continue to work through their phonics scheme, focussed sentence writing with capital letters, full stops and connecting words. Winter/Christmas themed writing will help to consolidate their sentence and phonic skills.  Yr2: Will continue to work through their phonics/spelling scheme, writing newspaper reports, poems and stories connected to Guy Fawkes, Winter poems and the Christmas story. Guided reading and comprehension weekly.</p>	<p><b><u>Seasonal Changes &amp; Christmas</u></b></p> 	<p><b><u>Maths</u></b>  Yr1: Will explore the number bonds to make numbers up to and including 10. They will begin to + and - using different methods and learn about 2D and 3D shape.  Yr2: Will add ones and tens to 2 digit numbers and learn the method of exchanging. Children will group numbers into arrays and use counting in 2s, 5s and 10s to learn multiplication facts. They will learn about coins and notes, make the same totals with different coins and solve money problems.</p>
<p><b><u>Science</u></b>  Seasonal Changes:  The children will be looking at the changes that take place in our environment as we progress from Autumn to Winter. We will learn about what is appropriate clothing as the seasons change. We will consider the weather changes and temperatures. The children will also learn about how animals prepare for the winter.</p>	<p><b><u>Why?</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Children to understand how the season changes and the differences that makes to us. Children to consider what Christmas means to different people and how we celebrate that in our own school and own home.</li> </ul>	<p><b><u>Geography</u></b>  London Landmarks:  We will be looking at the famous London Landmarks and their characteristics. The children will be learning how to use a map to locate them and also to track journeys around the city.</p>
<p><b><u>Art/ D&amp;T</u></b>  The children will be using their Art &amp; DT skills to make a yarn wrapped wreath, to decorate a bauble, to create a four seasons calendar and do other winter/Christmas themed pictures.</p>	<p><b><u>R.E.</u></b>  The topic 'What does Christmas mean to Christians?' will begin by looking at advent and how we get ready for new changes at home. The children will learn about Jesus's birth and will be rehearsing their nativity play.</p>	<p><b><u>PSCHE</u></b>  Through the topic of 'Valuing Differences' we will use Circle Time to explore the similarities and differences between people and explain the differences between unkindness, teasing and bullying. We will talk about being kind and fair and suggest how we can show kindness to others.</p>
<p><b><u>ICT</u></b>  Children will use Purple Mash, '2Paint a Picture' to explore and recreate paintings from Impressionist artists.</p>	<p><b><u>P.E.</u></b>  In our netball skills topic children will practise throwing and catching accurately with a partner; learning how to use space and to dodge</p>	

	opponents and begin to show some understanding of basic tactics.	
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
