Equator	The Equator is an imaginary line around the centre of the Earth.
North Pole	The North Pole is the northern end of Earth's axis.
South Pole	The South Pole is the southern end of Earth's axis.
Climate	The average pattern of weather conditions in an area.
Atlas	A book of different maps.
Weather	There are five primary different types of weather that can occur: sunny, rainy, windy, stormy, and cloudy.
Forecast	A prediction or guess about the future weather.

lion, tiger, meerkat, monkey, camel, scorpion, lizard, giraffe, hyena, rhino, elephant, cheetah, leopard, crocodile




Cold Places
The Arctic, Antarctica, poles, polar, snow, ice

Animals
penguin, polar bear, Arctic fox, reindeer, snowy owl, seal, walrus, wolf, Arctic hare




At the top and bottom of the Earth are the poles.




Places near the Equator are **hot**.
