

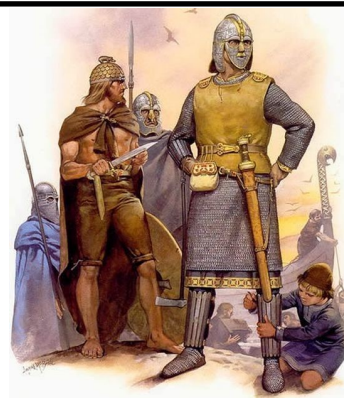
Key Stage 2, Years 5 and 6.

Term and duration: Term 2 Autumn
2022

English We will be reading 'There's a boy in the girls' bathroom.' We will explicitly look at vocabulary and key grammatical features, such as using parenthesis, complex sentences and advance punctuation. We will explicitly link our written work to our reading detective dogs: giving opportunities for inference, predictions and summaries. We will also read 'Beetle Boy' alongside this.

Vikings



History/Geography We will learn about the raids and invasions by Vikings in Anglo-Saxon Britain, finding out who the Vikings were as well as when and where they raided and settled. We will learn about significant events from the period and order these chronologically on a timeline. We will learn about different aspects of everyday Viking life and explore the types of houses that the Vikings lived in, what clothes they wore and even what types of food they ate.

Maths We will look at the four areas of calculation in detail, focusing on adding and subtracting mentally as well as using a formal written method; short and long multiplication; short division and long division (Y6 only), including remainders (and giving them as fractions and decimals) and having a decimal number as the dividend.

Why?

To enrich our understanding of how Britain has changed over the years.
To understand the influence that the Vikings had on life in Britain.

Foreign Language Our topic is 'Let's go shopping.' We will learn how to use the nuances of colour when describing the colours of clothes and how to use prepositional language. They will learn key phrases for asking the questions needed when going shopping.

Science We will be studying Light and how we see shadows, reflections and refractions. We will understand how light travels and how this enables us to see objects. We will carry out investigations to explore what happens when we bend light. We will research Isaac Newton and his theory of light and colour.

Religious Education We will be linking our work in RE to seasonal celebrations. We are going to explore why people believe in God and how this effects their everyday lives.

Art and Design We will engage in topic-based Art activities.

Computing We will be looking into Online Safety in ICT using Purple Mash. The children will be learning about digital footprints and the positive and negative influence that technology has on health and the environment.

PSHCE, British values and School Values

We will be following the SCARF curriculum for PSHCE and will learn about valuing differences: recognizing and reflecting on prejudice-based bullying and understanding bystander behaviour.

Design Technology and Cookery Children will apply their understanding of computing to program a floor robot. They will explore a range of adventure maps and use these to create original designs.

Physical Education Through our PE lessons we will learn how to play a range of team games including netball, football, basketball and tag-rugby and develop the skills required to play effectively.
