We will learn about the actions of King Ethelred II and the introduction of Danegeld before consider- ing what life was like living in the Viking era. We will then revise Viking laws and justice and then discover more about the last Anglo-Saxon Kings.

Year 4 children will revise length and perimeter and how these are cal- culated. All children will move onto multiplication and division, beginning with a focus on 2,4,8 times tables before moving onto 3,6 and 9x tables.
