The Forest Foodbank

Throughout 2023 we, as a school, collected over 107kg of food to help the foodbank, this is enough to create up to 256 meals! The food collected all goes to local families who are struggling. It takes over 3.4 tonnes of food a month to keep the foodbank running, which is why every donation no matter how small is greatly appreciated.

We will be collecting donations again during this year as we want to help people who are in crisis in our area. Keep an eye out for when we will be collecting and what items we will be looking for.

With the weather getting colder this week and possibly next, we would ask that you send your child to school with a warm coat along with gloves, scarves and hats if you have them. The wind is bitterly cold across the playground so wrap up warm!
