We will continue our work on multiplication and di- vision and will progress to more written methods of solving such calculations. We will continue to use TTR and My Maths to support the learning from the classroom. We will move on to look at units of meas- ure including money and how we can add and sub- tract pounds and pence. Year 3 will look at statistics, pictograms and bar charts in particular. We will learn how to count in tenths and to recognise differ- ent equivalent fractions.	Why? To develop our understanding of a non- European society that provides contrasts with British history. To inspire curiosity about the past and rec- ognise why the work of explorers helps us better understand past civilisations.	<u>Religious Education</u> We will be finding out about Islamic beliefs. We will revise what we can re- member about the 5 pillars of Islam. We will find out about how Muslims worship through fasting, prayer and some of the main celebrations fol- lowed.
