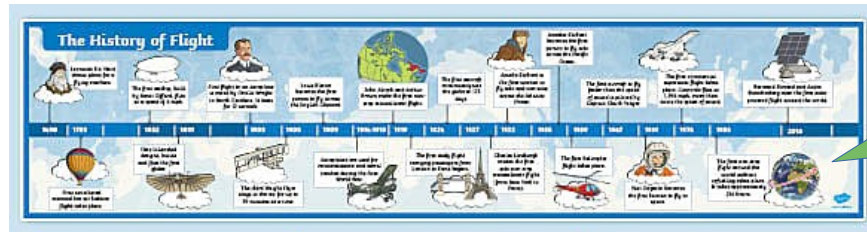

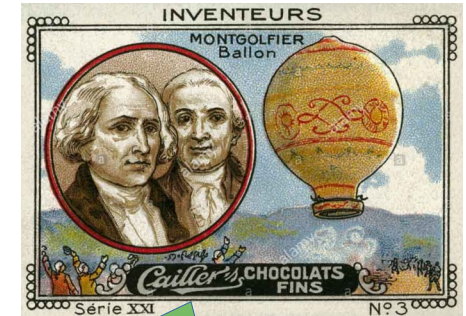
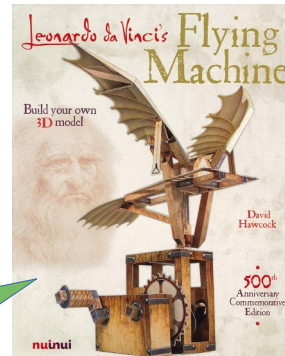
Timeline	A way of displaying events in the order they happened

Leonardo da Vinci	A famous artist who also drew plans for flying machines in 1490
Montgolfier Brothers	Famous pilots who were the first to fly hot air balloons in 1783
Wright Brothers	Famous pilots who were the first to fly an engine-powered aircraft in 1903
Amelia Earhart	The first woman pilot to fly solo across the Atlantic in 1932
Neil Armstrong	A famous astronaut who was the first man to walk on the moon in 1969
Transatlantic	Across the Atlantic
BC	Before Christ
AD	Anno Domini (After Christ was born)



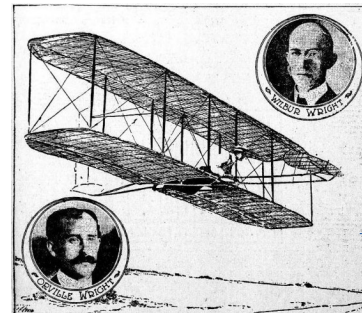
A timeline shows us the order events happened
