

paper	Thin material made from trees.
wood	A material from trunks of trees
metal	A material found in rocks.
plastic	A material made from chemicals.
glass	A material made from fine sand.
rubber	A stretchy material from tropical plants.
wool	A material from the hair of a sheep.
brick	Baked clay used for building walls.
fabric	Cloth made from weaving.
leather	A material made from animal skin.
rigid	Stiff, difficult or impossible to bend.
mouldable	Able to made into any shape.
flexible	Bends easily without breaking
fragile	Breaks easily.
delicate	Very fine, intricate, breaks easily.
magnetic	Attracts certain metals and both attracts and repels other magnets.
transparent	Lets light pass through easily, see-through.
translucent	Lets some light through.
opaque	Does not let any light through.
waterproof	Does not let water through.
absorbent	Soaks up liquid easily.


