<b>Country</b>	An area of land controlled by a government
<b>Continent</b>	A large area of land (which contains many countries)
<b>Flag</b>	A piece of cloth with a special design that represents a country
<b>Map</b>	A diagram of an area of land showing features, cities, rivers, roads etc
<b>City</b>	A place larger than a town where many people live closely together
<b>Population</b>	The number of people that live in a place
<b>Language</b>	The words people speak to communicate
<b>Landscape</b>	Natural scenery
<b>Landmark</b>	An important feature or building
<b>Symbol</b>	An item that represents something or someone
