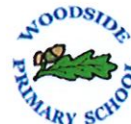

- **Sun hat**, and **weather-appropriate clothing**. We are asking the children to come in their PE kit for this trip please.
- A **light waterproof jacket**
- **Comfortable shoes** or **sandals** suitable for walking on sand
- A small backpack to carry their belongings

NO money needed for this trip.

Please apply all day sunscreen (preferably 50+) to your child before school.

If your child requires anti-sickness medication please administer before school.

We will be providing beach toys, including buckets and spades so there is no need for you to send your child with any of these items.
