

Key Stage 2 results 2024-25

Please note that this was a small cohort of **17 children**, so percentages are not statistically comparable to national figures.

Nationally, it is not possible to calculate key stage 1 to key stage 2 progress measures for 2023 to 2024 or 2024 to 2025 academic years. This is because there is no key stage 1 baseline available to calculate primary progress measures for these years, because of Covid disruption.
