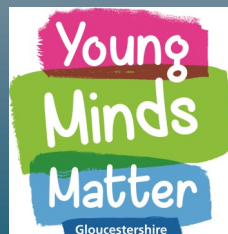
Class contact

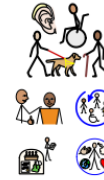
